ORDER

Acting in accordance with the Louisiana Constitution Article V, Section 1, the inherent power of this court and La. R.S. 1:55(E)(2),

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that 21ST Judicial District Court for the Parishes of Livingston, St. Helena, and Tangipahoa shall be closed on Monday, August 30, 2021. Resumption of normal operations during regular business hours on Tuesday, August 31, 2021, shall be contingent upon weather conditions and infrastructure impact from the tropical weather system. Litigants, court staff, members of the Bar, and the general public should monitor www.21stjdc.org for further information.

IT IS FURTHER HEREBY ORDERED that in accordance with La. R.S. 1:55(E)(2), the Clerks of Court for the Parishes of Livingston, St. Helena, and Tangipahoa shall publish a legal notice in the official Parish journal advising of this closure and shall attach a statement advising of the action to every petition or pleading filed in the Office of the Clerk of Court on the first day or part of a date that his/her office shall be reopened when such petition or document relates to a cause of action, right of appeal, or other matter against which prescription could have run or time periods imposed by law could have expired.
