**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that, as these proceedings are “on the record” court proceedings, proper attire is required.

**IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED** that the presence of anyone without the consent of the Court, or any recording of the Zoom proceedings by anyone other than the Court, may be considered contempt of court.

**IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED** that, in addition to pleadings, all motions, exceptions, memorandums in support, and memorandums in opposition must include the email address of the signatory in the signature block.
